As the enthusiasm caught on, a teacher who had been a girl's lacrosse coach at another high school along with his friend became the first two coaches.

Throughout the Fall of 2017 the team honed their skills, attracted more players, and by the Spring of 2018 started their first full season at Edison.

The inaugural season sported 66 players, 3 teams and 4 coaches. Since then, the EHS Girls Lacrosse program has continued to provide a safe, inclusive and competitive environment for girls to play lacrosse.
